Contracting considerations

- Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR)
 - for Federal purchases
- Defence Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS)
 - DoD contracts (in addition to FAR if working with defence agency)

US export control laws

- International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR)
 - all defence relation materials and items
- Export Administrations Regulations (EAR)
 - everything else i.e. commercial, dual-use, IT

What else might I need?

- Products subject to UK Export Controls will need an End User Undertaking (EUU) with the application
- US DoD contracts for goods, software or technology (subject to ITAR) require a Technical Assistance Agreement (TAA)

Items subject to UK
Export Controls, which
are returned for repair,
need an Export Licence
before they can be reexported to the US DoD.

Standard Individual Export Licence (SIEL)

Types of Licence

- most common
- for set quantity/value of goods
- goods addressed to stated person/company
- 2 year validity

Open General Export Licence (OGEL)

- used for dual-use and military equipment
- multiple use without reapproval
- subject to annual reporting & auditing

Open General Import Licence (OGIL)

 for import of goods to UK, subject to exceptions (firearms, anti-personnel mines, certain nuclear/chemical goods)
